Numbers 6 and 7 Monument Square (the Hubbell Row House) are three-story bow front brick Greek revival houses with cut stone and iron trim, a cut stone and granite foundation, and a slate gable roof. The main façade of 7 (the George Washington Warren house) has five bays with a center entrance, and 6 has three bays and a side entrance.
